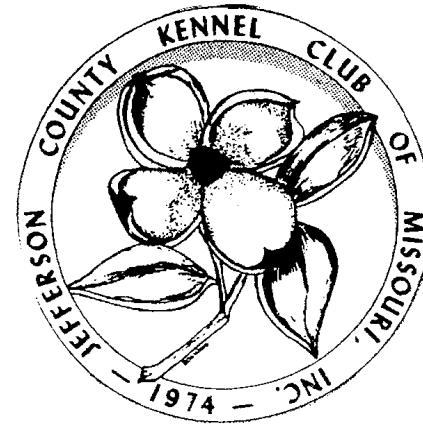

Wild Card Class Descriptions

Wild Card Novice

The Wild Card Novice class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Novice exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Novice class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, att a boy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice class.

Wild Card Open

The Wild Card Open class is for any dog capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Open A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, att a boy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Open A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Open class.

Wild Card Utility

The Wild Card Utility class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Utility A class, except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great, att a boy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Utility A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring, and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Utility class. Handlers are allowed to praise their dogs during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise.

Directions to Show Site



Exit #253 is the Gray Summit/Purina Farm exit. Exit # 257 is the Pacific exit

From the WEST (I-44) exit #253. Turn Right at top of ramp; turn Left at stop sign, onto W. Osage Rd. (old Rt. 66) Go east to Indian Warpath Rd. "Bo's Autorama" is on one corner, the high school is on the other. Turn Right onto Indian Warpath Dr., The Field is on your Left.

From the EAST (I-44) exit # 257. Turn Left at bottom of ramp, go under expressway. Turn Right at stop, onto W. Osage Rd. (old Rt. 66). Go west to Indian Warpath Rd. "Bo's Autorama" is on one corner, the high school is on the other. Turn Left onto Indian Warpath Dr., The Field is on your Left.

From the NORTH (Rt. 100). Pass the Purina Farm turn off, cross over I-44. Turn Left at stop sign, onto W. Osage Rd. (old Rt. 66). Go east to Indian Warpath Rd. "Bo's Autorama" is on one corner, the high school is on the other. Turn Right onto Indian Warpath Dr., The Field is on your Left.

Move-ups

Move-ups will be allowed at this trial per AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16 . For Saturday, Aug 8th trial: MOVE-UPS close at 7:30 am Central, Saturday, Aug 8th. For Sunday, Aug 9th trial: MOVE-UPS close at 7:30 am Central, Sunday, Aug 9th. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your move-up, an email confirmation will be sent.

Pre-Paid Catalogs

Catalogs may be pre-ordered by including \$2.00 for each with your entry fee and filling in the appropriate spaces on the entry form. Pre-paid catalogs will be available at the secretary's table. A LIMITED number of catalogs will be available the day of the show at \$3.00 each. **NOTE: This is a combined catalog, both days and ALL events are included.**

AKC Event & Recording Fees

A Recording Fee of \$0.50 cents and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.00 Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC Licensed or Member Club Events. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows).
 A Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry of each dog entered in any Rally Trial. (Chapter 1, Section 5 of Rally Regulations).
 Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 6 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, including ILP/PAL registration, and Approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 1 Section 14 of the Obedience Regulations for further restrictions. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate.

Notice to Exhibitors

The Trial Secretary is not responsible for Emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete the back of the entry form. Please include only AKC titles on your entries.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Post Dated and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Obedience/Rally Trials, the club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such a claim before judging commences on August 8, 2009.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the ring. All 'warm ups' MUST be done ONLEAD.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Jefferson County Kennel Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Jefferson County Kennel Club, their Board, Members, and The Field and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Jefferson County Kennel Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Trials.

Trial Information

- Please add the Trial Secretary's email address to your 'friendly/approved' list
- Trials will be held indoors, on soccer turf.
- Trial hours on Saturday and Sunday are 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.,
- Judging will start at 9:00 am on Saturday and at 8:30 am on Sunday.
- Food service is available at the trial site as well as near by Fast Food.
- Indoor Crating is Limited, be prepared to stack if needed.
- NO XPENS will be ALLOWED
- Food and Drink are not allowed on the soccer floor surface, Except on Tarp area
- Bring your own chairs and water for your dog.
